New car parking payment arrangements at the JR and Churchill Hospitals

There is now Automatic Number Plate Recognition in all visitor car parks at these 2 hospitals.

There are now no barriers across the entrances or exits to car parks. Instead your car registration number is photographed on entry and exit.

The first 30 minutes in any car park are free. This is to enable visitors time to find a space or wait for one to become free in busy times.

How to pay for parking, if you need more than 30 minutes

Payment is now by debit or credit card (contactless or chip and PIN) only. This applies to the car parking payment machines on site and if you opt to pay by phone or within 24 hours of leaving the site (see below).

If you do not have a card when you visit the hospital, you can pay by card online via the Simple Intelligent Parking website (www.sipcarparks.co.uk or www.sipcarparks.com) up to 24 hours after departure.

If you need to pay with cash, you will need to go to the relevant hospital car parking office before you leave (office details below).

If you leave without paying, or do not pay online within 24 hours, you will receive a Parking Charge Notice.

Options for paying

Pay on arrival

- a) If you definitely know how long you will be, you can pay by phone if you do not want to use a payment machine. Download the "Pay by Phone" app available from the Apple Store or Google Play.
 - You will need to know the hospital location code, which is displayed on the signs around the car parks and at the payment machines.
 - You can then pay by debit or credit card.
- b) If you are not sure how long you will be, you can pay at the payment machine(s) near the car park. Click on "I want to pay on arrival" enter your registration number choose your tariff (see below) then pay by debit or credit card (contactless or chip and PIN)
 - If when you leave you find that you have exceeded the time for which you have paid, you should go to the payment machine again and press the "I want to pay on arrival" button again and you will be told what to do and what to pay.

Pay on departure

You can pay at a payment machine near the car park. Click on "I am leaving now and want to pay" - enter your registration number and the terminal will say how much you owe —then pay by debit or credit card (contactless or chip and PIN)

Pay online within 24 hours of leaving the hospital site

NB. You can only use this method after you have driven out of the car park, so that your registration number can be photographed on exit.

Make sure you know the hospital location code before leaving the car park. This is displayed on the signs around the car parks and at the payment machines.

The car parks are run by the Trust and not as a commercial operation. All money raised goes directly back to patient and visitor services.

Disabled parking

JR

There are two dedicated Blue Badge Holder car parks: in front of the Children's Hospital (for West Wing and Children's Hospital) and between the Main Entrance and Car Park 2 (for the main hospital and Womens Centre). These are drive in/drive out, with no barriers. Please display your Blue Badge prominently. If you comply with these instructions, parking is free.

There are also disabled spaces in car parks 3 and 4, but if you want to use these spaces free of charge, you must register your vehicle via the <u>Simple Intelligent Parking website</u> (up to 24 hours after departure). If you do not register your vehicle and do not pay, you will receive a Parking Charge Notice

Churchill

Parking for Blue Badge holders is free.

Car Parks 3A and 4 are dedicated Blue Badge holder car parks. They are drive in/drive out with no barriers or ticketing. Please display your Blue Badge prominently. If you comply with these instructions, parking is free

If you park in any other car park, you must register your vehicle via the <u>Simple Intelligent</u> <u>Parking website</u> up to 24 hours after departure to park for free. If you do not register your vehicle, you will receive a Parking Charge Notice.
